- 2 2x4 @ 61 ½" (back legs)
- 2 2x4 @ 35 ¼" (front legs)
- 4 2x4 @ 22" (side aprons)
- 10 − 1x4 @ 39" (front aprons, short shelf boards, back shelf)



- 10 − 1x4 @ 42" (long shelf boards, back boards)
- 2 1x4 @ 24" both ends cut at 45 degrees, long point to short point measurement (cross support)


Shelving — Place shelving boards on bottom shelf.

Attach with about a ½" gap in between shelf boards with 2" exterior wood screws.

ends are cut at 45

degrees off square

Repeat for top shelf.





Cross bracing — cut cross bracing at 45-degree angles on ends.

Attach to back legs and the back-shelf board with 2" exterior wood screws and glue.



When wood filler is completely dry, sand the project in the direction of the wood grain with 120 grit sandpaper. Vacuum sanded project and work station to remove sanding residue. Wipe project clean with damp cloth.

Finish with paint, stain, polyurethane or other method you prefer.
